The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 03-425, concluding that KATHLEEN M. VELLA of LINWOOD, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1986, should be suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months for violating <u>RPC</u> 3.3(a) (lack of candor to a tribunal), <u>RPC</u> 4.1(a) (2) (failure to disclose a material fact to a third party in order to avoid assisting in a fraud), and <u>RPC</u> 8.4(c) (conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit or misrepresentation), and good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **KATHLEEN M. VELLA** is suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months and until the further Order of the Court, effective July 16, 2004; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent be restrained and enjoined from practicing law during the period of suspension and that respondent comply with <u>Rule</u> 1:20-20; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs incurred in the prosecution of this matter.
