ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciptinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule-1:20-17.
