AN ATTORNEY AT LAW

(Attorney No. 003981987) :

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 06-068, concluding that **PETER H. JACOBY** of **BEDMINSTER**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1987, should be suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months for violating <u>RPC</u> 8.4(c) (commission of a criminal act that reflects adversely on the lawyer's honesty, trustworthiness or fitness as a lawyer);

And the Court having granted respondent's petition for review and having ordered PETER H. JACOBY to show cause why he should not be disbarred or otherwise disciplined;

And the Court having determined from its review of the record that the appropriate quantum of discipline for respondent's unethical conduct is a censure;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **PETER H. JACOBY** is hereby censured; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further
