The Disciplinary Review Board has reviewed your conduct in the above matter and has concluded that it was improper. Specifically, in or about March 19, 1991, you were retained by Moyfrid Mazzella to represent her in connection with an appeal. Although you filed the appeal with the Appellate Division, you failed to correct certain deficiencies, as a result of which the appeal was dismissed in November 1991. You did not inform your client of the dismissal of the appeal. Your conduct was unethical and in violation of RPC 1.4 (a) and (b) and RPC 1.3.

Additionally, in May 1991, Moyfrid Mazzella retained you to file a complaint against Channel Home Center, arising out of a February 1991 incident. Although you filed the complaint, it was subsequently dismissed for lack of prosecution. Again, you failed to inform your client of this action. Your conduct was improper and violative of <u>RPC</u> 1.3 and <u>RPC</u> 1.4.

In imposing only an admonition, the Board considered that, at the time, you were saddled with personal problems and that no James A. Key, Jr., Esq. February 20, 1996 Page Two

disciplinary infractions have been sustained against you since 1974, the date of your admission to the New Jersey bar.

Your conduct adversely reflected not only upon you as an attorney but also upon all members of the bar. Accordingly, the Board has directed the issuance of this admonition to you. <u>R</u>.1:20-15(f)(4).

A permanent record of this occurrence has been filed with the Clerk of the Supreme Court and the Board's office. Should you become the subject of any further discipline, it will be taken into consideration.

The Board has also directed that the costs of the disciplinary proceedings be assessed against you. An affidavit of costs will be forwarded under separate cover.
