Dear Mr. Finkelstein:

The Disciplinary Review Board has reviewed the motion for discipline by consent (admonition) filed by the District VIII Ethics Committee in the above matter. After a review of the record, the Board determined to grant the motion and to issue a letter of admonition.

Specifically, in July 1995, you were retained by James Gieb to represent him in connection with an automobile accident that occurred that same month in New York. You did not provide him with a retainer agreement. After you filed a complaint in the matter, you did not reply to discovery requests. Although the case was eventually settled, you failed to send the appropriate releases to the insurance carrier. Eventually, you paid the settlement from your own funds. You also failed to provide information about the status of the matter, as requested. Your conduct was unethical and a violation of <u>RPC</u> 1.1(a) (gross neglect), <u>RPC</u> 1.3 (lack of diligence), and <u>RPC</u> 1.4(a) failure to communicate with client).

Your conduct adversely reflected not only upon you as an attorney, but also upon all members of the bar. Accordingly, the Board has directed the issuance of this admonition to you. <u>R</u>. 1:20-15(f)(4).
