**LETTER OF ADMONITION**

Dear Mr. Gadye:

The Disciplinary Review Board has reviewed your conduct in the above matter and has concluded that it was improper. Specifically, on September 15, 1997 you were declared ineligible to practice law in New Jersey for failure to pay the 1997 annual assessment to the New Jersey Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection. Notwithstanding your ineligible status, on or about January 29, 1998 you filed an order to show cause with the Superior Court of New Jersey, Special Civil Part, Middlesex County. Your conduct was improper and in violation of RPC 5.5(a).

In mitigation, the Board considered that, at the time, you were beset by familial problems and that no disciplinary infractions had been sustained against you since your admission to the New Jersey bar in 1987.


Your conduct adversely reflected not only upon you as an attorney, but also upon all members of the bar. Accordingly, the Board has directed the issuance of this admonition to you. R. 1:20-15 (f) (4).

A permanent record of this occurrence has been filed with the Clerk of the Supreme Court and the Board's office. Should you become the subject of any further discipline, it will be taken into consideration.
