LETTER OF ADMONITION

Dear Mr. Payton:

The Disciplinary Review Board has reviewed your conduct in the above matter and has concluded that it was improper. Specifically, on September 16, 1993 you filed a complaint on behalf of Paula E. Jones, four days after the expiration of the statute of limitations. Ms. Jones was not informed of the filing of the complaint or of the fact that it was filed late. Ultimately, the complaint was dismissed for lack of prosecution. You did not inform Ms. Jones of the dismissal. Your conduct was unethical and in violation of <u>RPC</u> 1.1 (a), <u>RPC</u> 1.3 and <u>RPC</u> 1.4 (a).

In imposing only an admonition, the Board considered that you were a new and inexperienced attorney at the time of the infraction, having been admitted to the New Jersey bar only one year before.

Your conduct adversely reflected not only upon you as an attorney, but also upon all members of the bar. Accordingly, the Board has directed the issuance of this admonition to you. \underline{R} . 1:20-15 (f) (4).

A permanent record of this occurrence has been filed with the Clerk of the Supreme Court and the Board's office. Should you become the subject of any further discipline, it will be taken into consideration.
