The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 11-267, concluding that **JERROLD N. KAMINSKY** of **KENDALL PARK**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1977, should be suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months for his unethical conduct in six matters, including violation of <u>RPC</u> 1.2(assisting a client in conduct the attorney knows is illegal, criminal or fraudulent), <u>RPC</u> 1.7(a) (conflict of interest), and <u>RPC</u> 8.4(c) (conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit or misrepresentation), and good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **JERROLD N. KAMINSKY** is suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months and until the further Order of the Court, effective April 9, 2012; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent comply with $\underline{\text{Rule}}$ 1:20-20 dealing with suspended attorneys; and it is further

ORDERED that pursuant to $\underline{\text{Rule}}$ 1:20-20(c), respondent's failure to comply with the Affidavit of Compliance requirement of $\underline{\text{Rule}}$ 1:20-20(b)(15) may (1) preclude the Disciplinary Review

Board from considering respondent's petition for reinstatement for a period of up to six months from the date respondent files proof of compliance; (2) be found to constitute a violation of $\overline{\text{RPC}}$ 8.1(b) and $\overline{\text{RPC}}$ 8.4(c); and (3) provide a basis for an action for contempt pursuant to $\overline{\text{Rule}}$ 1:10-2; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in $\underline{\text{Rule }}$ 1:20-17.
