KASDAN, formerly of ENGLEWOOD CLIFFS, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1978 and who was thereafter suspended from practice for a period of three months on June 18, 1989, and who remains suspended at this time, is hereby suspended from practice for a period of three years, effective immediately and until the further Order of the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall be restrained and enjoined from practicing law during the period of her suspension and that she shall comply with Administrative Guideline 23 of the Office of Attorney Ethics, which governs suspended attorneys; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall not be reinstated to practice unless and until she submits competent psychiatric evidence of her fitness to practice law; and it is further

ORDERED that on reinstatement to practice respondent shall practice under the supervision of a proctor satisfactory to the Office of Attorney Ethics until the further Order of the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall reimburse the Ethics Financial Committee for appropriate administrative costs incurred in the prosecution of this matter.
