The Disciplinary Review Board having reported to the Court, recommending that **ROBERT F. HENN** of **MIDLAND PARK**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1966, be publicly reprimanded for failing to pursue a client's interests with due diligence (in violation of <u>RPC</u> 1.3), for making misrepresentations to his client and failing to keep the client informed (in violation of <u>RPC</u> 1.4(a)), for violating the record-keeping requirements of <u>Rule</u> 1:21-6, and for failing to cooperate with disciplinary authorities (in violation of <u>RPC</u> 8.1(b)), and good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **ROBERT F. HENN** is hereby publicly reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of repondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further ORDERED that respondent shall reimburse the Ethics Financial Committee for appropriate administrative costs incurred in the prosecution of this matter.
