This matter have been duly presented pursuant to <u>Rule 1:20-10(b)</u>, following the granting of a motion for discipline by consent in DRB 13-160 of **MARC PRENTISS FELDMAN** of **MORRIS PLAINS**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1988;

And the District XA Ethics Committee and respondent having signed a stipulation of discipline by consent in which it was agreed that respondent violated RPC 1.2(a) (a lawyer shall abide by a client's decision concerning the scope and objectives of the representation), RPC 1.5(a) (unreasonable fee), and RPC 8.4(c) (conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit or misrepresentation);

And the parties having agreed that respondent's conduct violated  $\underline{RPC}$  1.2(a),  $\underline{RPC}$  1.5(a) and  $\underline{RPC}$  8.4(c), and that said conduct warrants a censure or lesser discipline;

And the Disciplinary Review Board having found that respondent violated only  $\underline{RPC}$  8.4(c), the sole violation supported by the stipulated facts, and that a censure is the appropriate

discipline for respondent's unethical conduct and having granted the motion for discipline by consent in District Docket No. XA - 2011-0020E;

And the Disciplinary Review Board having submitted the record of the proceedings to the Clerk of the Supreme Court for the entry of an order of discipline in accordance with <a href="Rule">Rule</a> 1:20-16(e);

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that MARC PRENTISS FELDMAN of MORRIS PLAINS is hereby censured; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
