And the Disciplinary Review Board having referred to the Supreme Court Professional Responsibility Rules Committee the question of the applicability of comments regarding <u>RPC</u> 1.8(e) in the report of the Supreme Court Committee on the Model Rules of Professional Conduct (<u>Debevoise Report</u>);

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that the Professional Responsibility Rules Committee examine RPC 1.8(e) in light of the comments to that Rule in the <u>Debevoise Report</u> and report to the Court the view of the Committee on whether the comment should apply to <u>RPC</u> 1.8(e) and if so, whether <u>RPC</u> 1.8(e) should be amended; and it is further

ORDERED that on the basis of the findings of the Disciplinary Review Board and the action of the Court in respect of <u>RPC</u> 1.8(e), the complaint against **VINCENT CIECKA** be and hereby is, dismissed.
