And the parties having agreed that respondent's conduct violated <u>RPC</u> 1.1(a), <u>RPC</u> 1.1(b), <u>RPC</u> 1.15(a), <u>RPC</u> 1.15(d), <u>Rule</u> 1:21-6, <u>RPC</u> 5.3(a) and <u>RPC</u> 8.4(c), and that said conduct warrants a censure or lesser discipline;

censure is the appropriate discipline for respondent's unethical conduct and having granted the motion for discipline by consent in District Docket No. XIV-2012-00408E;
