And the District XII Ethics Committee and respondent having signed a stipulation of discipline by consent in which it was agreed that respondent violated <u>RPC</u> 1.1(a)(gross neglect), <u>RPC</u> 1.3 (lack of diligence), <u>RPC</u> 1.4(b)(failure to keep the client reasonably informed about the status of the matter and promptly comply with reasonable requests for information), <u>RPC</u> 1.4(c)(failure to explain a matter to the extent reasonably necessary to permit the client to make informed decisions regarding the representation), and <u>RPC</u> 8.4(c)(conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit or misrepresentation);

And the parties having agreed that respondent's conduct violated <u>RPC</u> 1.1(a), <u>RPC</u> 1.3, <u>RPC</u> 1.4(b), RPC 1.4(c), and <u>RPC</u> 8.4(c), and that said conduct warrants a reprimand, and the Disciplinary Review Board having determined that a reprimand is the appropriate discipline for respondent's ethics violation and having granted the motion for discipline by consent in District Docket No.XII-2009-0002E; And the Disciplinary Review Board having submitted the record of the proceedings to the Clerk of the Supreme Court for the entry of an order of discipline in accordance with <u>Rule</u> 1:20-16(e);

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **STEVEN H. MARKS** of **PLAINFIELD** is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further
