The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 08-006, concluding that as a matter of final discipline pursuant to <u>Rule</u> 1:20-13(c), **PAUL STEPHEN BEATTY** of **SPRING LAKE**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1990, should be suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months based on his conviction in the Superior Court, Monmouth County of violation of <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 2C:12-10(b), conduct that violates <u>RPC</u> 8.4(c) (criminal act that reflects adversely on lawyer's honesty, trustworthiness or fitness as a lawyer), and good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **PAUL STEPHEN BEATTY** is suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months and until the further Order of the Court, effective August 13, 2008; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and is a further

ORDERED the espondent comply with <u>Rule</u> 1:20-20 dealing with suspendent corneys; and it is further

failure to comply with the Affidavit of Compliance requirement of Rule 1:20-20(b)(15) may (1) preclude the Disciplinary Review Board from considering respondent's petition for reinstatement for a period of up to six months from the date respondent files proof of compliance; (2) be found to constitute a violation of <u>RPC</u> 8.1(b) and <u>RPC</u> 8.4(c); and (3) provide a basis for an action for contempt pursuant to <u>Rule</u> 1:10-2; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
