
SUPREME COURT OF NEW JERSEY D-59 September Term 2007



The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 07-251, concluding on the record certified to the Board pursuant to <u>Rule 1:20-4(f)</u> (default by respondent), that **AVIS COLE WILLIAMS** of EGG HARBOR TOWNSHIP, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1987, should be censured for violating <u>RPC</u> 8.1(b) (failure to cooperate with disciplinary authorities), and good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **AVIS COLE WILLIAMS** is hereby censured; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
