The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 00-331, recommending that DAVID S. BRANTLEY of EAST ORANGE, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1970, be disbarred for violating <u>RPC</u> 1.1(a) (gross neglect), <u>RPC</u> 1.1(b) (pattern of neglect), <u>RPC</u> 1.3 (lack of diligence), <u>RPC</u> 1.4(a) (failure to communicate), <u>RPC</u> 1.5 (failure to communicate basis of fee in writing), <u>RPC</u> 1.16(d) (failure to return unearned retainer), and <u>RPC</u> 8.1(b) (failure to cooperate with ethics authorities), and said DAVID S. BRANTLEY having been ordered to show cause why he should not be disbarred or otherwise disciplined, and good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **DAVID S. BRANTLEY** is suspended from the practice of law for a period of two years and until the further Order of the Court, effective April 15, 2002; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further ORDERED that respondent be restrained and enjoined from practicing law during the period of suspension and that respondent comply with <u>Rule</u> 1:20-20; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs incurred in the prosecution of this matter.
