ORDER

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 02-458, concluding that as a matter of reciprocal discipline pursuant to <u>Rule</u> 1:20-14 **ANTHONY C. BRUNEIO** of **CHERWAY, SOUTH CAROLINA**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1991, should be disciplined based on respondent's discipline in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for conduct in violation of <u>RPC</u> 1.1(a) (gross neglect), <u>RPC</u> 1.3 (lack of diligence), <u>RPC</u> 1.4(a) (failure to communicate with client), <u>RPC</u> 1.5(a) (excessive fee), <u>RPC</u> 1.15(b) (failure to deliver funds to which client or third person is entitled), <u>RPC</u> 1.16(d) (failure to refund unearned retainer), <u>RPC</u> 5.3(c) (failure to supervise a non-lawyer employee), and <u>RPC</u> 8.4(d) (conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit of misrepresentation);

And the Disciplinary Review Board having further concluded that respondent should not be reinstated to the practice of law in this State unless and until restored to practice in Pennsylvania;

And ANTHONY C. BRUNEIO having failed to appear on the return date of the Order to Show Cause issued in this matter; And good cause appearing; .

It is ORDERED that **ANTHONY C. BRUNEIO** is suspended from the practice of law for a period of five years and until the further Order of the Court, effective immediately; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent be restrained and enjoined from practicing law during the period of suspension and that respondent comply with Rule 1:20-20; and it is further

ORDERED that **ANTHONY C. BRUNEIO** shall not be reinstated to the practice of law in New Jersey unless and until respondent is reinstated to the practice of law in Pennsylvania; and it is further


ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further
