ORDERED that respondent comply with $\underline{\text{Rule}}\ 1:20\text{--}20$ dealing with disbarred attorneys; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight

Committee for appropriate administrative costs incurred in the

prosecution of this matter.
