The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 00-393, concluding that pursuant to <u>Rule</u> 1:20-14, **MICHAEL J. ROSENBLATT** of **NEW YORK, NEW YORK**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1988, should be suspended from the practice of law for a period of six months, respondent having been disciplined in the State of New York for conduct in violation of <u>RPC</u> 8.4(c) (dishonesty, fraud, deceit or misrepresentation) and <u>RPC</u> 8.4(d) (conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice), and good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that MICHAEL J. ROSENBLATT is suspended from the practice of law for a period of six months and until the further Order of the Court, effective immediately; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

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ORDERED that respondent be restrained and enjoined from practicing law during the period of suspension and that respondent comply with <u>Rule</u> 1:20-20; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs incurred in the prosecution of this matter.
