ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF : LOUIS F. WILDSTEIN, : AN ATTORNEY AT LAW :

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 00-028 concluding that LOUIS F. WILDSTEIN of NEWARK, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1978, should be suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months for violating <u>RPC</u> 1.1(a) (gross neglect), <u>RPC</u> 1.4(b) (failure to explain a matter to the extent reasonably necessary to permit the client to make an informed decision regarding the representation, <u>RPC</u> 1.7(a), (b) and (c) (conflict of interest), <u>RPC</u> 1.8(a) (conflict of interest/prohibited transaction), <u>RPC</u> 1.8(c) (preparation of an instrument giving the attorney a substantial testamentary gift) and <u>RPC</u> 8.4(c) (conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit or misrepresentation); and good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that LOUIS F. WILDSTEIN is suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months and until the further Order of the Court, effective August 1, 2001; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further ORDERED that respondent be restrained and enjoined from practicing law during the period of suspension and that respondent comply with <u>Rule</u> 1:20-20; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs incurred in the prosecution of this matter.
