The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 02-302, concluding that as a matter of reciprocal discipline pursuant to Rule 1:20-14, PETER L. KATZ of UNION, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1990, should be suspended from the practice of law for a period of seven years and not reinstated to practice unless and until reinstated in New York;
