This matter have been duly presented to the Court pursuant to <u>Rule</u> 1:20-10(b), following a granting of a motion for discipline by consent in DRB 16-028 of **JAMES JOHN CALLAHAN** of **JERSEY CITY**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1982;

And the Office of Attorney Ethics and respondent having signed a stipulation of discipline by consent in which it was agreed that respondent violated <u>RPC</u> 1.1(a) (gross neglect), <u>RPC</u> 1.3(lack of diligence), <u>RPC</u> 1.4(b) (failure to communicate with the client), and <u>RPC</u> 1.15(b) (failure to promptly deliver funds to a third party);

And the parties having agreed that respondent's conduct violated <u>RPC</u> 1.1(a), <u>RPC</u> 1.3, <u>RPC</u> 1.4(b) and <u>RPC</u> 1.15(b), and that said conduct warrants a reprimand or lesser discipline;

And the Disciplinary Review Board having determined that a reprimand is the appropriate discipline for respondent's unethical conduct and having granted the motion for discipline by consent in District Docket No. XIV-2014-0419E;

And the Disciplinary Review Board having submitted the record of the proceedings to the Clerk of the Supreme Court for the entry of an order of discipline in accordance with <u>Rule</u> 1:20-16(e);

And respondent having supplemented the record before the Court with information about the estates;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **JAMES JOHN CALLAHAN** of **JERSEY CITY** is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in <u>Rule</u> 1:20-17.
