And the parties having agreed that respondent's conduct violated RPC 3.4(c) (knowingly disobeying an obligation under the rules of a tribunal), RPC 5.5(a)(1) (unauthorized practice of law)) and RPC 8.4(d) (conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice, and that said conduct warrants a reprimand or lesser discipline as the Board may deem appropriate;

And the Disciplinary Review Board having declined to find the

stipulated violation of RPC 8.4(d) and having determined that a reprimand is the appropriate discipline for respondent's unethical conduct and having granted the motion for discipline by consent in District Docket Numbers IV-2015-0019E and IV-2016-0024E;

Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses

incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in <u>Rule</u>
