And the parties having agreed that respondent's conduct violated <u>RPC</u> 1.4(b), <u>RPC</u> 1.5(b) and <u>RPC</u> 8.4(d), and that said conduct warrants a reprimand or lesser discipline;

And the Disciplinary Review Board having determined that a

reprimand is the appropriate discipline for respondent's unethical conduct and having granted the motion for discipline by consent in District Docket Nos. IIIB-2015-0043E and IIIB-2016-0027E;

And the Disciplinary Review Board having submitted the record of the proceedings to the Clerk of the Supreme Court for the entry of an order of discipline in accordance with <u>Rule</u> 1:20-16(e);

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **KAREEM J. CRAWFORD** of **BURLINGTON** is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
