ORDER

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 18-337, recommending that **Dwight Hugh Day, a/k/a Dwight Hugh Simon Day, of Newark, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2004, be** disbarred for violating <u>RPC</u> 1.15(a)(knowing misappropriation of trust funds)and the principles of <u>In re Wilson</u>, 81 <u>N.J.</u> 541 (1979), <u>RPC</u> 1.15(d) and Rule 1:21-6 (recordkeeping violations), <u>RPC</u> 8.1(b)(failure to cooperate withdisciplinary authorities), and <u>RPC</u> <math>8.4(c)(conduct involving dishonesty, fraud,deceit or misrepresentation);

And Dwight Hugh Day, a/k/a Dwight Hugh Simon Day, having been ordered to show cause why he should not be disbarred or otherwise disciplined;

And the Court having considered the briefs and argument of the parties and having determined from its review of the matter that there was not clear and convincing evidence that respondent knowingly misappropriated client trust funds; that any misappropriation of funds in violation of <u>RPC</u> 1.15 (a) was negligent; and having concluded that disbarment is not warranted;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that Dwight Hugh Day, a/k/a Dwight Hugh Simon Day, is hereby censured; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in <u>Rule</u> 1:20-17.
