The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 20-021 concluding that **Aram Ingilian** of **Ridgefield**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2000, should be suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months for violating <u>RPC</u> 8.4(d)(conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice) and <u>RPC</u> 8.4(e)(stating or implying an ability to improperly influence a government agency or official to achieve results by means that violate the <u>Rules of Professional Conduct</u> or other law);

Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in <u>Rule</u> 1:20-17.
