The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 20-295, concluding that **Stanley R. Sherer** of **Hawthorne**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1985, should be reprimanded for violating RPC 1.15(a)(commingling of funds; failure to safeguard client funds and the funds of third parties; and negligent misappropriation), RPC 1.15(b)(failure to deliver to client or third person any funds the client or third person is entitled to receive), RPC 1.15(d)(failure to comply with recordkeeping requirements), and RPC 8.1(b)(failure to cooperate with disciplinary authorities);

And the Disciplinary Review Board having determined that respondent should be required to reimburse the clients and third parties identified, and in the amounts specified, in the disciplinary proceedings within sixty days after the Court's Order, and to deposit the funds belonging to any clients or parties whom he cannot locate into the Superior Court Trust Fund within sixty days after the Court's Order;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Stanley R. Sherer** is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall reimburse the clients and third parties identified, and in the amounts specified, from in the disciplinary proceedings within sixty days after the Court's Order and shall deposit the funds belonging to any of said clients or parties whom he cannot locate into the Superior Court Trust Fund in accordance with Rule 1:20-7 (j) within sixty days after the Court's Order; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight

Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in <u>Rule</u> 1:20-17.
