The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 23-007, recommending as a matter of final discipline pursuant to Rule 1:20-13(c), that **Jon Charles Cooper**, of **Washington**, **District of Columbia**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1994, and who has been suspended from the practice of law since January 20, 2023, be disbarred following respondent's guilty plea and conviction, in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, for one count of federal income tax evasion, in violation of 26 U.S.C. § 7201, and for violating RPC 8.4(b) (committing a criminal act that reflects adversely on the lawyer's history, trustworthiness, or fitness as a lawyer) and RPC 8.4(c) (engaging in conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit, or misrepresentation);

And **Jon Charles Cooper** thereafter having tendered his consent to disbarment;

And the Court this date having disbarred Jon Charles Cooper, by

consent (D-113-22);
