LETTER OF ADMONITION

Dear Ms. Armorer-Stimpson:

The Disciplinary Review Board has reviewed your conduct in the above matter and has concluded that it was improper. Specifically, on November 11, 1991 you were retained by Naima A. Abdullah to represent her in a potential suit against her former employer for gender and/or race discrimination and unlawful termination of employment. You then filed a civil complaint in your client's behalf. When your representation was terminated in or about March 1993, your client requested the return of certain documentation and tape recordings in the file. You refused to do so until she paid your outstanding legal fee. Your conduct was unethical and in violation of RPC 1.16(d).

In imposing only an admonition, the Board considered that ultimately you returned to your client the documents and/or tapes that were in your possession.

Your conduct adversely reflected not only upon you as an attorney, but also upon all members of the bar. Accordingly, the Board has directed the issuance of this admonition to you. \underline{R} . 1:20-15 (f) (4).

A permanent record of this occurrence has been filed with the Clerk of the Supreme Court and the Board's office. Should you become the subject of any further discipline, it will be taken into consideration.
