LETTER OF ADMONITION

Dear Mr. Ejiogu:

The Disciplinary Review Board has reviewed your conduct in the above matter and has concluded that it was improper. With the approval of the Supreme Court, the Board has concluded that an admonition is the appropriate discipline for your misconduct. Specifically, after the OAE conducted a select audit of your attorney accounts on July 15, 1998, numerous recordkeeping deficiencies were found, in violation of \underline{R} .1:21-6 and \underline{RPC} 1.15(d). In addition, the audit disclosed that you had failed to comply with contingent fee agreements, in violation of \underline{R} .1:21-7.

Your conduct adversely reflected not only upon you as an attorney, but also upon all members of the bar. Accordingly, the Board has directed the issuance of this admonition to you. \underline{R} . 1:20-15 (f) (4).

A permanent record of this occurrence has been filed with the Clerk of the Supreme Court and the Board's office. Should you become the subject of any further discipline, it will be taken into consideration.
