**LETTER OF ADMONITION**

Dear Mr. Rendo:

The Disciplinary Review Board has reviewed your conduct in the above matter and has concluded that it was improper. After a careful review of the record, the Board has determined to impose an admonition.

Specifically, the letterhead of your law firm, Garber & Rendo, was required to indicate the jurisdictional limitations on those attorneys not licensed to practice in New Jersey. Your partner, Irwin Garber, was admitted to practice law in New York, but not in New Jersey. Although the law firm's letterhead identified Garber as admitted to practice law in New York, it did not identify Garber as admitted to practice law only in New York. Your use of a misleading letterhead constituted a violation of RPC 7.1(a) and RPC 7.5(a).

In imposing only an admonition, the Board took into consideration your unblemished disciplinary record since your admission to the New Jersey bar in 1994.

Your conduct adversely reflected not only upon you as an attorney, but also upon all members of the bar. Accordingly, the Board has directed the issuance of this admonition to you. R. 1:20-15(f)(4).

A permanent record of this occurrence has been filed with the Clerk of the Supreme Court and the Board's office. Should you become the subject of any further discipline, it will be taken into consideration.

The Board also has directed that the costs of the disciplinary proceedings be assessed against you. An invoice of costs will be forwarded under separate cover.
