LETTER OF ADMONITION

Dear Mr. Harriott:

The Disciplinary Review Board reviewed the motion for discipline by consent (admonition) filed by the Office of Attorney Ethics. Following a review of the record, the Board determined to grant the motion and to impose an admonition. Specifically, you practiced law while ineligible to do so for failure to pay the annual assessment to the New Jersey Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection. Your conduct was unethical and a violation of RPC 5.5(a).

In the Matter of Christopher K. Harriott

In imposing only an admonition, the Board considered that your conduct was unintentional, as you were unaware that your employers had failed to pay the annual assessment. When you became aware of your ineligible status, you promptly cured your ineligibility.

Your conduct has adversely reflected not only upon you as an attorney but also upon all members of the bar. Accordingly, the Board has directed the issuance of this admonition to you. R. 1:20-15(f)(4).

A permanent record of this occurrence has been filed with the Clerk of the Supreme Court and the Board's office. Should you become the subject of any further discipline, it will be taken into consideration.

The Board has also directed that the costs of the disciplinary proceedings be assessed against you. An invoice of costs will be forwarded under separate cover.
