LETTER OF ADMONITION

Dear Mr. Main:

The Disciplinary Review Board has reviewed your conduct in the above matter and has concluded that it was improper. Following a review of the record, the Board determined to impose an admonition.

Specifically, you were retained after about 2004 to represent Lazar Gozenpud for injuries sustained in a December 2003 automobile accident. Gozenpud alleged that you had grossly neglected his matter. When the ethics investigator sought information from you about the representation, you ignored two letters requesting your version of the events. Because you did not reply to those requests for information, a complaint was issued. In your answer, you substantiated the legal work that you completed on Gozenpud's behalf, prompting the presenter to withdraw the gross neglect charge against you. You conceded,

however, that you failed to cooperate with the investigation, a violation of \underline{RPC} 8.1(b).

In imposing only an admonition, the Board considered that you have had no final discipline since your 1988 bar admission.

Your conduct has adversely reflected not only upon you as an attorney but also upon all members of the bar. Accordingly, the Board has directed the issuance of this admonition to you. R. 1:20-15(f)(4).

A permanent record of this occurrence has been filed with the Clerk of the Supreme Court and the Board's office. Should you become the subject of any further discipline, it will be taken into consideration.

The Board has also directed that the costs of the disciplinary proceedings be assessed against you. An invoice of costs will be forwarded under separate cover.
