The Disciplinary Review Board having filed a report with the Court, recommending that HOWARD S. BORDEN, JR. of TOMS RIVER, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1958, be suspended from the practice of law for six months for violations of DR 6-101(A), DR 7-101(1), DR 9-102(B)(4), DR 1-102(A)(4), RPC 1.1(a), RPC 1.2(a), RPC 1.3, RPC 1.15(b), and RPC 8.4(c), and good cause appearing;


It is ORDERED that the report and recommendation of the Disciplinary Review are adopted and HOWARD S. BORDEN, JR. is hereby suspended for a period of six months, effective November 5, 1990, and until the further Order of the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall be restrained and enjoined from practicing law during the period of his suspension and that he shall comply with Regulation 23 of the Administrative Guidelines Governing Suspended Attorneys; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall reimburse the Ethics Financial Committee for appropriate administrative costs incurred in the prosecution of this matter.
