The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 01-398, concluding that ROWLAND V. LUCID, JR., of MORRISTOWN, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1968, should be reprimanded for violating RPC 5.5(a) (unauthorized practice of law) by practicing law while ineligible to do so by reason of failure to pay his annual assessment to the New Jersey Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection, and good cause appearing;
