The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 13-026, concluding that RONALD $C$. HUNT of NEWARK, who was admitted to the bar of this state in 1985, should be reprimanded for violating RPC 1.1 (a) (gross neglect), RPC 1.3 (lack of diligence), RPC $1.4(b)$ (failure to keep client reasonably informed about the status of a matter), RPC 1.4(c) (failure to explain a matter to the extent necessary for client to make informed decisions about representation), RPC 1.7 (b) (concurrent conflict of interest), Rule $1: 21-6$ and RPC $1.15(d)$ ) (recordkeeping violations), REC $1.16(a)(1)$ (lawyer shall not represent a client or shall withdraw from representation if representation will result in RPC violation), $\mathrm{RPC} 1.16(\mathrm{~d})$ (failure to protect client's rights on termination of representation), RPC 8.1(a) (false statements in connection with disciplinary matter), and RPC 8. 4 (c) (conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit or misrepresentation), and good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that RONAID $C$. HUNT is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
