The Disciplinary Review Board has reviewed your conduct in above matter and has concluded that it was Following a review of the record, the Board determined to impose an admonition.

Specifically, in 2009 and 2010, you admittedly failed to cooperate with the district ethics committee's attempts obtain information from you about your 2008 representation of James Bordes in an expungement matter. Your failure to reply to the committee constituted a violation of RPC 8.1(b).

The Board dismissed the remaining charges against you for lack of clear and convincing evidence.

In imposing only an admonition, the Board considered that you have had no other final discipline since your 1983 admission to the New Jersey Bar.
