Dear Mr. Steig:

The Disciplinary Review Board reviewed the motion for discipline by consent (reprimand or such lesser discipline as the Board shall deem warranted), filed by the District VC Ethics Committee (DEC) in the above matter, pursuant to \underline{R} . 1:20-10. Following a review of the record, the Board determined to grant the motion and to impose an admonition.

Specifically, in 2011, you undertook the representation of Andrew Montana, whom you had not regularly represented, in a landlord-tenant dispute. However, you did not provide Mr. Montana with a writing, setting forth the basis or rate of the fee, either before or within a reasonable time after commencing the representation, a violation of <u>RPC</u> 1.5(b).

Your conduct has adversely reflected not only upon you as an attorney but also upon all members of the bar. Accordingly, the Board has directed the issuance of this admonition to you. <u>R.</u> 1:20-15(f)(4).
