The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 13-353, concluding that **CYNTHIA A. And the Court having determined from its review of the matter that an admonition is the appropriate quantum of discipline for respondent's unethical conduct;


And good cause appearing;

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further


