

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 11-135, concluding that **ARLEEN CABALLERO**GONZALEZ of LINWOOD, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1984, should be suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months for violating RPC 1.1(b) (pattern of neglect), RPC 1.3(lack of diligence), and RPC 1.5(b) (failure to provide client with a writing setting for the basis or rate of the legal fee);

And the Disciplinary Review Board having further concluded that prior to her reinstatement to the practice of law, respondent should be required to provide proof of her fitness to practice law and should complete courses in law office management, and that after reinstatement, she should be required to practice under supervision for a period of two years;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **ARLEEN CABALLERO GONZALEZ** is suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months and until the further Order of the Court, effective immediately; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall continue to comply with the

Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
