
The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 11-018, concluding on the record certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-4(f) (default by respondent), that **NEIL L. ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17; and it is further


ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State.
