The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 14-116, concluding that **JAMES A. KEY**, **JR.**, of **FORDS**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1974, should be censured for violating <u>RPC</u> 1.15(d) (recordkeeping violations), <u>RPC</u> 3.1(asserting a frivolous claim), and <u>RPC</u> 5.3 (failure to supervise non-lawyer employees);

And the Disciplinary Review Board having further concluded that respondent should be required to complete a course in law office management and submit proof of his satisfactory completion to the Office of Attorney Ethics within ninety days after the filing date of the Court's Order;

And good cause appearing;

ORDERED that within ninety days after the filing date of this Order, respondent shall enroll in and satisfactorily complete a course in law office management, and thereafter shall

submit proof of his completion thereof to the Office of Attorney Ethics; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary

Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and
actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as
provided in Rule 1:20-17.
