The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 07-027, concluding on the record certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-4(f) (default by respondent), that **AVERY C. PILGRIM** of IRVINGTON, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1985, should be disbarred for violating RPC 1.15(a) and (d) (failure to safeguard funds and recordkeeping violations), RPC 8.4(c) (conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit or misrepresentation), and the principles in In re Wilson, 81 N.J. 451 (1979) and In re Hollendonner, 102 N.J. 21 (1985);

And **AVERY C. PILGRIM** having failed to appear on the Order to Show Cause issued in this matter;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **AVERY C. PILGRIM** be disbarred, effective immediately, and that his name be stricken from the roll of attorneys;

ORDERED that **AVERY C. PILGRIM** be and hereby is permanently restrained and enjoined from practicing law; and it is further


ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a

permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further


ORDERED that respondent comply with Rule 1:20-20 dealing with disbarred attorneys; and it is further
