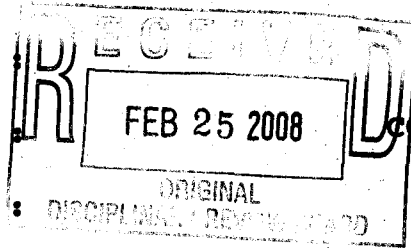

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 07-251, concluding on the record certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-4(f) (default by respondent), that **AVIS COLE WILLIAMS** of **EGG HARBOR TOWNSHIP**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1987, should be censured for violating RPC 8.1(b) (failure to cooperate with disciplinary authorities), and good cause appearing;
