The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 06-091, concluding that **ANTHONY S. FILOMENO** of **WAYNE**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1990, should be suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months for violating RPC 8.4(b) (criminal conduct that reflects adversely on an attorney's honesty, trustworthiness or fitness as a lawyer), and that because of respondent's rehabilitation, the term of suspension should be suspended;

And **ANTHONY S. FILOMENO** having been ordered to show cause why he should not be disbarred or otherwise disciplined;

And the Court having determined that the appropriate quantum of discipline is a censure;

And good cause appearing;


It is ORDERED that **ANTHONY S. FILOMENO** is hereby censured; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this


State; and it is further
