CORRECTED LETTER OF ADMONITION

Dear Mr. Kranzler:

The Disciplinary Review Board has reviewed your conduct in the above matter and has concluded that it was improper. Specifically, on September 30, 1996 you were declared ineligible to practice law in New Jersey for failure to pay the annual assessment to the New Jersey Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection for the calendar year 1996. Notwithstanding your ineligibility, you accepted representation and filed a complaint in a matter titled <u>Sara Wigdor et als. v. Chandavadan Majmundar et als.</u> Your conduct was unethical and in violation of <u>RPC</u> 1.16(a) and <u>RPC</u> 5.5(a).

In imposing only an admonition, the Board noted that, prior to this incident, no disciplinary infractions had been sustained against you since your admission to the New Jersey bar in 1992.

Your conduct adversely reflected not only upon you as an attorney, but also upon all members of the bar. Accordingly, the Board has directed the issuance of this admonition to you. \underline{R} . 1:20-15 (f) (4).
