O R D E R

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision concluding that **GERALD M. ALSTON** of **PHILADELPHIA, PENNSYLVANIA**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1989, should be suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months for violating RPC 5.5(a) (failure to maintain a bona fide office), RPC 8.1 (making false statement of fact in connection with a disciplinary matter) and RPC 8.4(c) (misrepresentation); and good cause appearing;


It is ORDERED that **GERALD M. ALSTON** is suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months and until the further Order of the Court, effective immediately; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further


ORDERED that respondent be restrained and enjoined from practicing law during the period of suspension and that respondent comply with Rule 1:20-20; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs incurred in the prosecution of this matter.
