And the Office of Attorney Ethics and respondent having further agreed that respondent should be required to provide the Office of Attorney Ethics with proof of his continued treatment

And the Disciplinary Review Board having determined that a censure is the appropriate discipline for respondent's unethical conduct and having granted the motion for discipline by consent in District Docket Nos. XIV-2015-0149E, XIV-2015-0150E, and XIV-2015-0151E;

And the Disciplinary Review Board having further determined that respondent should be required to provide the Office of Attorney Ethics with proof of respondent's continued treatment by a mental health professional through 2016;

And the Disciplinary Review Board having submitted the record of the proceedings to the Clerk of the Supreme Court for the entry of an order of discipline in accordance with <u>Rule</u> 1:20-16(e);

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that JOSEPH ALBANO of HASBROUCK HIGHTS is hereby censured; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall submit proof to the Office of ?
Attorney Ethics of his continued treatment by a mental health professional approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics through 2016; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
