The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 16-165, concluding on the record certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-4(f) (default by respondent), that **ANDREY V. ZIELYK**, formerly of **PARSIPPANY**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1986, and who has been temporarily suspended from the practice of law since February 10, 2015, should be censured for violating RPC 8.1(b) (failure to cooperate with disciplinary authorities) and RPC 8.4(d) (engaging in conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice), and good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **ANDREY V. ZIELYK** is hereby censured; and it is further



ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
